Subject: Swimming Pool

As are many of you, we are hopeful that we can open the pool soon. We are awaiting approval from various entities and until those approvals come, we cannot promise when or if we can open. We are proceeding as if we will get approval as we made necessary repairs and will begin painting soon.

We've partnered with several nearby private clubs and pools that empowered an attorney (member of one of the clubs) to submit a proposal to coincide private pool openings with the timing of youth sports which are tentatively scheduled to resume on June 15th. Again, we're hopefully optimistic.

When we do open, much like the changes we've had to make with the golf course there will be changes to the pool as well. These changes will be driven by the proposal that we joined with the previously mentioned group.

A partial list of the changes:

- Members Only – no guests. This includes grandchildren, babysitters, etc.
- Maximum Pool occupancy will be established.
- Deck furniture will be re-arranged to comply with Social Distancing.

We hope to have firm answers soon, in the meantime thanks for your patience and cooperation.

Wanted to remind everyone of our policy for handicapping our M.G.A. Tournaments.

The following statement is posted on the entry forms for:

The Jungle

All players must have an established HDCP with at least 6 scores submitted by June 1 to be eligible for the Calcutta.

Overall, everyone has done really good job this of posting their scores, so with the deadline quickly approaching, I would like to ask a couple of things:

1. If you're unsure of the number of rounds you've posted, we have a list it in the Pro-Shop of all golfers with less than 6 Rounds as of May 28th, 2020.
2. Make sure that the person you are bringing as a guest to the Jungle is posting their Rounds as has at least 6.

We will work with you as we have time especially with The Jungle not until late July. What we don't want is someone jamming in 6 scores at the last minute. (Work with Jimmy on this, please)

Also, for any other events that have and use HDCP's this has been and will continue to be on the entry forms:

- When prize money is paid out (as it is here) we are requesting that golfers have at least 6 scores posted prior to the event.
- This gives those of you that are currently short, time to be compliant.
- Failure do so will mean that you can only compete in the Gross categories.

I really appreciate your cooperation and support on this. It makes things run so much smoother.

- Families and kids are welcome – all you need is a putter and ball.
- Open to ALL Members – Full and Limited
- Friday, June 12th
- Tee Times every 10 minutes beginning at 5:30 PM with the last Tee Time at 7:00 PM.

Format

- This is a 'putting only' event, all 9 holes, **NO HANDICAPS ARE USED**
- Putt from the markers the we will place on each green.
- Form your own team. Best **3 scores** on each green will count towards the team total.
 - You can have up to 6 players on a team.
- Teams may be mixed, all men, all women, families, kids, etc.
- Team contest **IS NOT A SCRAMBLE.** each player putts out each hole.
- Record scores for each player, each hole and then record best score of the team on the highlighted line, maximum individual score of 4 for all players.
- Prizes are for:
 - Best INDIVIDUAL
 - Best TEAM SCORES
- No 'Gimmies'

Rules

- If there is a team on the green please wait 50 yards from the green
- No practice putting on the greens
- If a ball leaves the green, replace as close as possible from the point of exit, back onto the green within 2 inches of the edge, 1 stroke penalty
- Youngest team member putts first on their first hole, rotate team honors each hole after that.
- **Continuous putting is highly encouraged to keep play flowing**
- Beverage Stations will be located on the course – you will be given options to pay prior to playing so no money transactions are needed once on the course.
- There may or may not be "obstacles" on the greens to navigate around, so be prepared.

This is a great way to have some fun, get a little exercise (walking encouraged) and introduce someone to the game.

 - (6 Flights* – based on 96 players – Flighted after Saturday's Round)
 - Could add a flight depending on scores.
 - You will be placed in 1 of 3 groups based on HDCP. Group A, B or C.
 - You cannot play your way into or out of either group.
 - Championship and 1st Flights will be Group A and all play White/Blue tee's
 - Ball will be played "up" in your own fairway and down everywhere else.
 - 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Flights will be Group B and C and have senior tee option (Gold/Black Tees) at 60 years old.
 - B and C will play the ball "up" everywhere.

Cost: \$125 – Members/\$150 – Non Members (1 Rider per cart option) See box below for more details.

Prize Money: (Per Flight) TBD – We have 30 carts (1 rider per cart) and offering different playing options.

Special Events:

- Box Lunch both days (Included in entry fee)

Joe Mooney Men's Invitational – June 27th/28th

- We are going ahead with plans to have it, with changes made to accommodate Social Distancing requirements as well as just plain old common sense to keep everyone safe.
- You can see most of the changes on the entry form, but we won't have everything finalized until we truly know how many players are participating.
- As it stands, this will be the 1st Tournament that will allow Guests to play.
- The biggest issue right now is the cart situation. We have 30 carts at the club and will be offering the following options.
 - ✓ **1st 60 PAID entries are guaranteed a cart (1) Rider Per Cart.**
 - **Update** – we are off to a good start with early entries, so don't put it off.
 - ✓ You have 2 options to walk:
 - You can carry your clubs or use a push/pull cart.
 - You can walk and we will put your clubs on a cart with another player. That player will always drive, and you will always walk.
 - ✓ **Update** - As clubs around us slowly start allowing 2 riders per cart, we are considering that as a possibility as well. Especially with those that travel in together from out of town. More to come on that, but again the sooner you enter, the sooner we can get things buttoned up.
- Food
 - Box lunches only and they will be provided both days.
- Tee Times
 - As always, the Mooney utilizes tee-times.
- Calcutta
 - We still plan on having some sort of Calcutta, still working out the details of what that will look like.

FRIDAY, JULY 3rd

- One rider per cart unless members of the same household or you are comfortable riding with your teammate.
- Members may invite (1) guest per team and you must ride with them, so choose wisely. Ha.
- No lingering before or after play. Go to your cart and then the assigned hole.
- There will be no rules announcements, etc. Below is rule sheet.

Cost: \$5.00 per player (Plus applicable cart fee (Members \$17, Guests \$32))

- Put your own foursome together.
- We will have only 24 carts by the time this event occurs:
 - The 1st to sign-up get a cart.
 - Tee-Times: You must take one or the other:
 - 9:00 AM (First to sign up and PAY get the carts)
 - 2:00 PM (First to sign up and PAY get the carts)
- We will begin taking tee-times for this event 7 days prior. (June 26th)
- Open to Men and Women **with an established HDCP. (See below)**

FORMAT: AMBROSE

For a 3-person scramble, add all three individual handicaps and divide by 6.

For a 4-person scramble, add together and divide the total by 8.

The arithmetic above produces one team handicap to use during play.
