Members

Once again, thank you for your support of the club during these unprecedented times. Your support has enabled us to keep the "wolf from the door" during this pandemic.

The Pro-Shop staff and Grounds Crew have done an incredible job and continue to help provide us all with a safe outdoor activity.

What we are doing to keep you safe:

- The CCC does not want anybody to visit the course if they are feeling sick, have a fever or shortness of breath, or have been exposed to a person infected with COVID-19.
- Pool noodles have been placed in the bottom of the cups, so keep the flag sticks in place on the greens.
- The sand traps will not have rakes so players should lift their ball out of the sand.
- Only (1) Rider per cart unless both live in the same household.
- Tee -times are at 15-minute intervals. (No shotgun starts)
- Walking is always an option and is free for members.
- 19th Hole, Pro Shop and Lounge are closed. We will only be offering pre-packaged snacks as our food choices for now.
- You can use
- Venmo to purchase merchandise, cart rental, food/beverage, etc.
- We are sanitizing counter tops, bathrooms and carts throughout the day.
- Limiting bathroom visits to one person at a time.

What we're asking from our members as we move into the next few weeks:

Tee Times:

- They are required to guarantee you a cart. (All days, not just weekends)
- We now have 30 carts and they can go quick, so even if it's a weekday, it helps us go ahead and get them out and sanitized well ahead of time.
- As previously stated, Tee-times are scheduled 15 minutes apart. We ask that when you show up, please pay and play as quickly as possible.
- The only way to guarantee a Tee-Time is to call the Pro Shop at (859)234-5364.

Carts:

- It is a good idea to ask an attendant if the cart you're ready to take has been cleaned before beginning your round. (You are welcome to bring your own cleaning supplies as well to be super safe. It will not offend us)
- As previously stated, (1) rider per cart unless living in the same household. Note that riding as singles tends to speed up play and if we have walkers intermingled, we will get into a situation where we need to be continue to be courteous of one another.
- Would ask that everyone starts at Hole #1 as much as possible.
- Guest Policy: We're are 100% members only until further notice.



- Tournament/Calendar update for May:
 - May 16th/17th PGA Pick a Pro: postponed to August 8th & 9th
 - May 25th Memorial Day Scramble: Changed from Scramble to Stroke Play (see following sheet)
 - Note we could see this moved back to our popular scramble format, but for right now, it doesn't look like large crowds and shotgun starts need to be planned for.
 - May 29th/30th Gerald & Bonnie Classic: Postponed TBD
- The Mooney June 27th/28th
 - Plans to have The Mooney are still on but probably with changes.
 - We can organize this pretty quickly and at worst, I can see us doing a "Members Only Mooney" as we use tee-times and can accommodate at least 60 players if we are still riding as singles.

The Cynthiana Country Club is proud to announce that they have partnered with the prestigious Men's Golf Association to bring the MGA Monthly Tournament Series to the C.C.C.

The MGA Monthly Tournament will be a "Virtual" Tournament in which the best 4 scores that are played and posted at the C.C.C for that particular month will be totaled to determine the best scores.

Rules/Details

- The events are flighted as such.
 - A/B Group = 0.0 to 9.9 HDCP
 - C/D Group = 10.0 to 15.9 HDCP
 - E/F Group = 16.0+ HDCP
 - Note, these could change as the year progresses depending upon how many players are in each group.
 - Each "Group" will have 2 Flights separated by scores. You cannot play yourself into or out of a Group. (Same as the Mooney)
- Gross Scores only, No HDCP's used
- Must play and post 4 rounds at the Cynthiana Country Club Away rounds don't count.
 - If you play more than 4, your best 4 rounds are used, so the more you play, the better chance you have.
- When looking at the following scores for April, you will see scores in RED. That means
 that the golfer still needs to post rounds to get to 4 and their lowest score thus far was
 projected out.
 - If a golfer has already posted 4 rounds, they can continue to play and if they post
 a lower round than what they have so far, it will be added and their highest round
 will be taken off.
- Entry Fee Free
- Prizes per Flight CCC Gift Certificates good for merchandise/food/beverages.
 - 1st \$10.00, 2nd \$5.00 (Tie/breaker = most rounds posted)

The Flights are named after some of the original CCC Founding Members and contributor



Monday, May 25th (All Day)

We are assuming that we will still be under our current COVID-19 restrictions which means:

- One rider per cart unless members of the same household
- · Members Only
- No Shotgun Starts

All the above limits our ability to have our popular Holiday Scrambles, so to stay safe and provide our Members with a fun format we're going to have a Blind Squirrel Tournament. You will play with your own group, but once play is completed, we will draw out your partner (or partners) depending on the number of players we have. Combine all the scores and award the winners.

Cost: \$5.00 per player (Plus applicable cart fee)

- Put your own foursome together.
- Tee-Times are MANDATORY to reserve a cart.
- We will begin taking tee-times for this event 7 days prior. (May 18th)
- *Note that this is a voluntary tournament. You can still play that day without participating in this tournament.
- Open to Men and Women with an established HDCP. (See below)

FORMAT: 18 Holes Stroke Play

- Play your own ball, record your score and turn in your scorecard to the Pro-Shop.
- Gross and Net (100% HDCP used)
 - You can win in one category, not both. Pay 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
 - We will figure Gross first and then Net.
 - Too complicated, no worries, just go play and turn in your scorecard.

Very Important

- In an effort to encourage golfers to have a HDCP and post their scores, whenever we have any tournaments, whether they be MAJOR or MINOR (such as this one) the HDCP committee would request the following:
 - When prize money is paid out (as it is here) we are requesting that golfers have at least 6 scores posted prior to the event.
 - This gives those of you that are currently short, time to be compliant.
 - Failure do so will mean that you can only compete in the Gross categories.
