Please keep carts at least 30 ft. from any green. Please use the sand available on the carts and at the tee boxes to fill divots. Otherwise, you know the drill: sand divots in the fairways, repair ball marks on the greens and leave rakes IN the sand traps. Thank you.

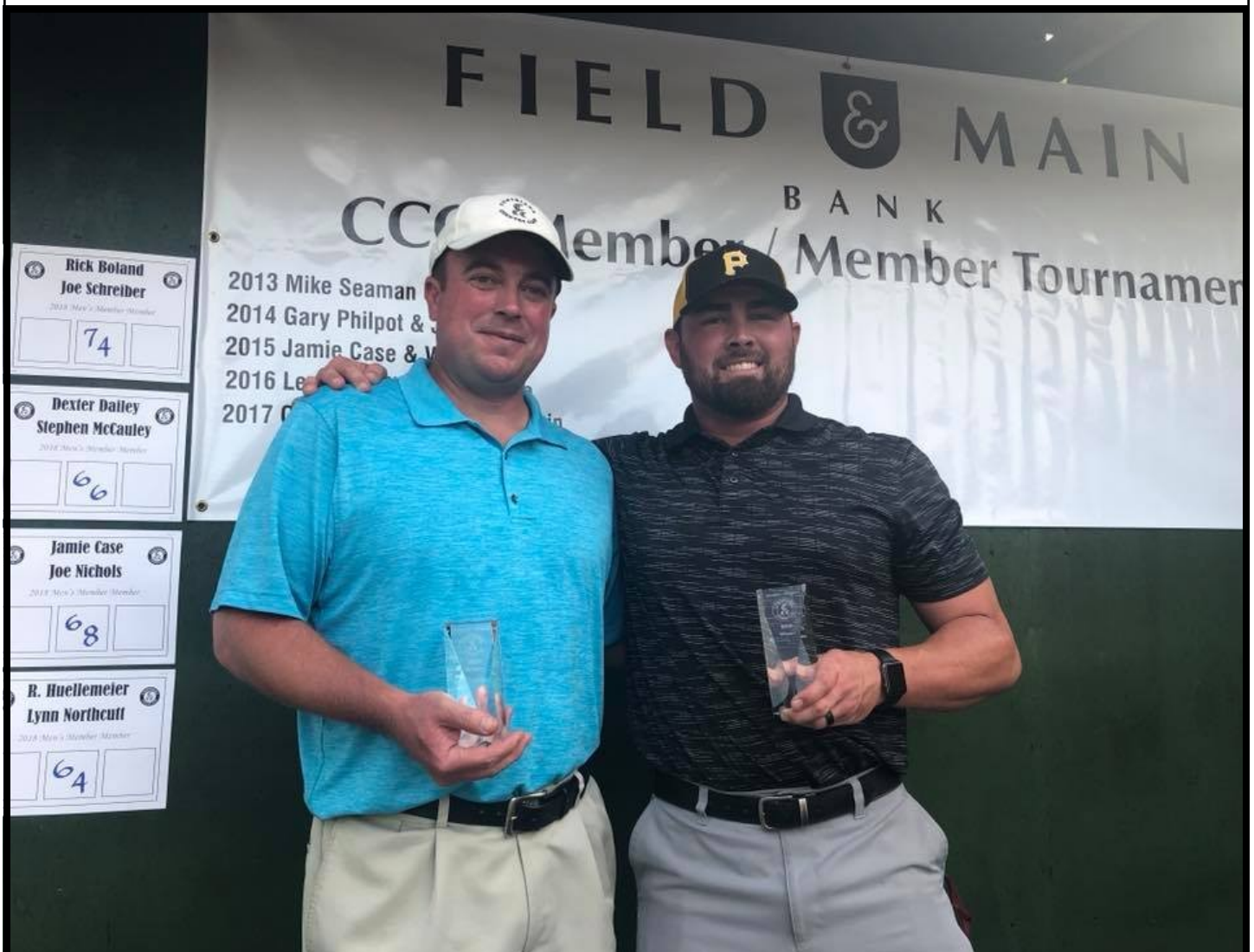

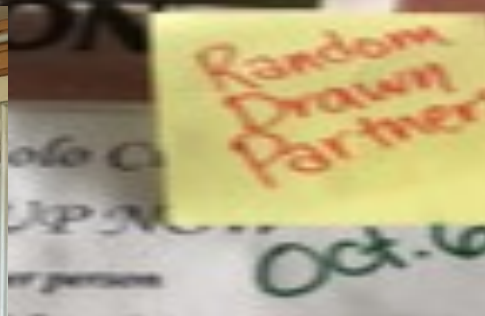

- **Division 1 - Club Champion (No HDCP's used)**
 - Maximum length to the golf course. White and Blue tees all the way back, ball played down everywhere.
- **Division 2 - Senior Club Champion (No HDCP's used)**
 - Gold and black tees played still longer than where seniors usually play. Ball played up in the Bermuda grass only, down everywhere else
- **Division 3 - handicapped**
 - Open to all members not in the other 2 divisions. Gold and black tees, ball played up everywhere. Match play with dots given on hardest holes. Players get no more than one dot per hole.

CCC Board Meeting July 9th, 2018

Board Members Present:

Minutes from the June Board Meeting were approved.

- **Financial Report:**

- Given by David McIlvain. 185 Members to date which is the most in the past 6 years. Ahead in revenue and net profit versus last year. Discussed the 6% sales tax on Bank Draft members. Between 19 and 22 of the 51 on Bank Draft have adjusted theirs with Edward Jones. Board will continue to follow-up and monitor.
- Motion to approve the Financial Report: Gary Philpott, 2nd Chase Wachter. Motion carried.

Staff Report:

- **Jimmy Fuller**

- Discussed this week's upcoming Jungle (Member/Guest) Tournament. We have 56 teams signed up.
- Discussed making a statement at the Burley Belles potluck as well as all tournaments reminding members and guests not to bring alcohol onto the property as the ABC has visited us numerous times over the past couple of months and we want to remain legal.

Old Business

- **3m Club proposal**

- Based on the same plan that we have for Harrison Memorial Hospital, which is 1 paid member per every 10. The remaining 9 members would pay \$650 each. (Due to this being the 3M club and not a business, we increased the overall price to average out at \$750.00 per, rather than \$717.00) We would reserve the right to make changes, with proper notice if this agreement proved unprofitable for the club. (exact proposal and details are in an email from Mike Aldridge to Steve Hill which the Board was copied on)
- Motion to approve by Ray Sparks, 2nd Frank Henson. Motion carried

New Business:

- Discussed moving Super Senior Tee's from 75 to 70 for next year. This was determined to be an MGA matter and will be discussed at an MGA meeting in the fall/winter prior to setting the 2019 Tournaments. Also discussed having more favorable distances between the White/Blue Tee's and the current Senior Tee's (Black/Gold). Ray Sparks to discuss with Mike/Grant.
- Motion made by Gary Philpott and 2nd by Carl Nunnelley to adjourn. Motion carried.
