JUNE BOARD MINUTES

CCC Board Meeting June 24th, 2019

Board Members Present: Mike Aldridge, Ray Sparks, Ray Huellemeier, Carl Nunnelley, Gary Varner
Absent: Shain Stephens, Kelly Kendall Staff Present: Jim Fuller, Mike Lenox, Amanda Aldridge, Grant Howard • Minutes from the May Board Meeting were read and approved.

- Financial Report: David McIlvain o We have 176 Members versus 190 last year. o Total Expenses are up \$6700 vs LYR o Total Revenue is down \$\$16,000 vs LYR o P&L is down \$23,000 vs LYR o Motion to approve the Financial Report: Ray Sparks, 2nd Carl Nunnelley. Motion carried.

Staff Report: • Jim Fuller o Reported that the Joe Mooney Men's Invitational had 77 players and resulted in a little over \$10,000 in revenue generated between cart fees, sponsorships, food & beverage. o July 4th Scramble is almost full. We have 5 carts remaining. o The Jungle sign-ups are under-way and a full field is expected. o Baby Pool Pump was affected by a power surge and repairs will have to be made. Not sure of the extent. o Board discussed the need to get the Power Washer fixed and a new Blower. • Mike Lenox/Grant Howard o Discussed constant flooding into the cart barn. Working with Carl Nunnelley for a solution.

Old Business

- Highway work – State Representative Mark Hart continues to be in communication with the State on our behalf with the water run-off from the project. The changes made recently seemed to have improved the situation and we will continue to monitor and let Mr. Hart know of any concerns.
- Tabs – During the Mooney, we had 3 Members and 1 Non-Member that failed to pay their tabs. The amounts were minimal, but we will still need to pursue. It was also discussed that Members are uncomfortable leaving their Credit/Debit cards with us over the course of a two-day tournament and the Board agreed. Ray Sparks is to write up a Tab Policy, send to the Board for approval and inform the membership.
- Insurance changes on the club were discussed, no action taken. • Cart Cards – Re-visited the discussion regarding having a Cart Card where members can purchase a pre- paid card allowing Members a set number of rounds at a reduced price. Motion to approve by Ray Huellemeier and 2 nd by Carl Nunnelley. Motion carried. Ray Huellemeier agreed to develop the card and have Amanda process and communicate to the membership.
- New Business:
 - Scrambles Policy – Ray Sparks to write up a new policy that encourages organizations to host their charity scrambles with us on Mondays and Fridays versus Saturdays which interfere with our Members. • Golf Merchandise. Discussed that we have a lot of money tied up in shoes and apparel which have slow sales compared to balls, tees, etc. Motion made by Ray Sparks and 2nd by Carl Nunnelley to liquidate our inventory of golf shoes and apparel. If a Member wants those type of items, the club can order at a discount. Motion to adjourn made by Ray Huellemeier and 2nd by Carl Nunnelley. Motion carried. Minutes submitted by Ray Sparks
