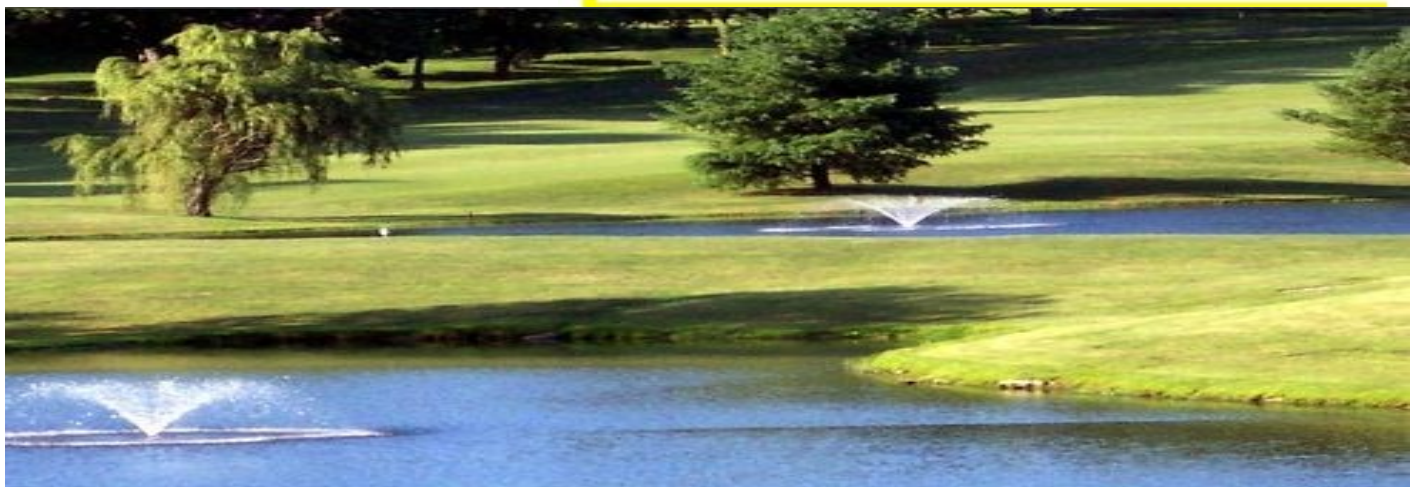

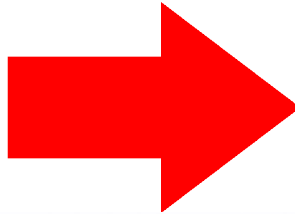

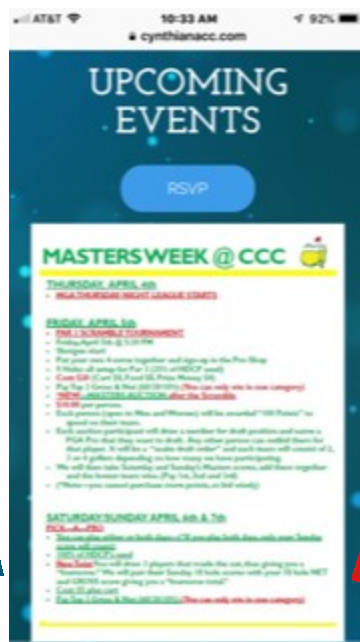

## NEW TAX LAWS

Effective last year on July 1, 2018, the Kentucky State Legislature enacted new tax laws that affected the Golf industry. The only things that WILL NOT BE taxed are Gift Certificates and GHIN numbers, everything else we sell is taxable including memberships. This will be in full effect this season. In the past the club has absorbed the difference and we simply cannot continue to do that and be fiscally responsible.

# APRIL BOARD MINUTES

CCC Board Meeting April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019

Board Members Present: Mike Aldridge, Ray Sparks, Ray Huellemeier, Carl Nunnelley

Staff Present: Jim Fuller, Mike Lenox

Minutes from the March Board Meeting were approved.

- Financial Report: David McIlvain
  - We have 139 Members versus 127 at the same time last year.
  - Revenue is lighter than hoped for due to weather, but finances are stable.
  - Motion to approve the Financial Report: Ray Sparks, 2<sup>nd</sup> Carl Nunnelley. Motion carried.

Staff Report:

- Jim Fuller
  - Reported that the Thursday Men's League was off to a good start with 38 paid players the 1<sup>st</sup> week.
  - Scramble scheduled for April 29<sup>th</sup> to benefit Darrel Baxter's granddaughter is almost full.
- Mike Lenox
  - Will be sodding soon on some greens and tee boxes where we have damage.
  - Will be getting quotes to repair the walk-behind greens mower to reduce stress on the greens when mowing the clean-up near the collars. This should help alleviate some of the stress and worn spots from the greens mower.

## Old Business

- Highway work – Ongoing discussions are being had with the State regarding the water runoff, etc from the construction. They have communicated that they have a plan and will present to the board in a few weeks.
- 3M Club Membership – have discussed the fact that we haven't picked up enough new members with the agreement. Motion made by Ray Sparks and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carl Nunnelley to advise 3M that we need 15 more members to continue the agreement in 2020. Motion carried
- PGA Youth on Course Program – Motion made by Ray Huellemeier and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ray Sparks to participate in the program that provides youth in our community access to golf. This is a national program and administered by the Kentucky Golf Foundation. We will allow access on Monday's only. Motion carried.

## New Business:

- Sales Tax on Room Rental - Motion made by Ray Huellemeier and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ray Sparks to add 6% sales tax charge to Room Rentals rather than continuing to absorb it in the cost. Motion carried.
- Pool cleaning and painting. Motion made by Carl Nunnelley and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ray Sparks to accept the \$600 quote from Hank Whalen to ready the pool for use. (Same cost as last year). Motion carried.
- Red Cross/Water Aerobics – Motion made by Ray Sparks and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carl Nunnelley to accept Kelly Brunker's proposal for swimming lessons and water aerobics. (Same as last year) Motion carried.
- Discussed the possibility of offering a "Cart" Card similar to a Meal Card that members could purchase. Tabled until the May Board meeting.....no action taken.

Motion to adjourn made by Ray Huellemeier and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carl Nunnelley. Motion carried.

# MESSAGE FROM MAINTENANCE



Use 90 Degree Rule, in fairways! Please keep carts at least 30 ft. from any green. Please use the sand available on the carts and at the tee boxes to fill divots. Otherwise you know the drill: sand divots in the fairways, repair ball marks on the greens and leave rakes IN the sand traps. Please keep all carts out of the area between #5 white tee & #6 green. The cart traffic is causing serious erosion in that area.
