Spring Cleaning Sale Continues May 12!



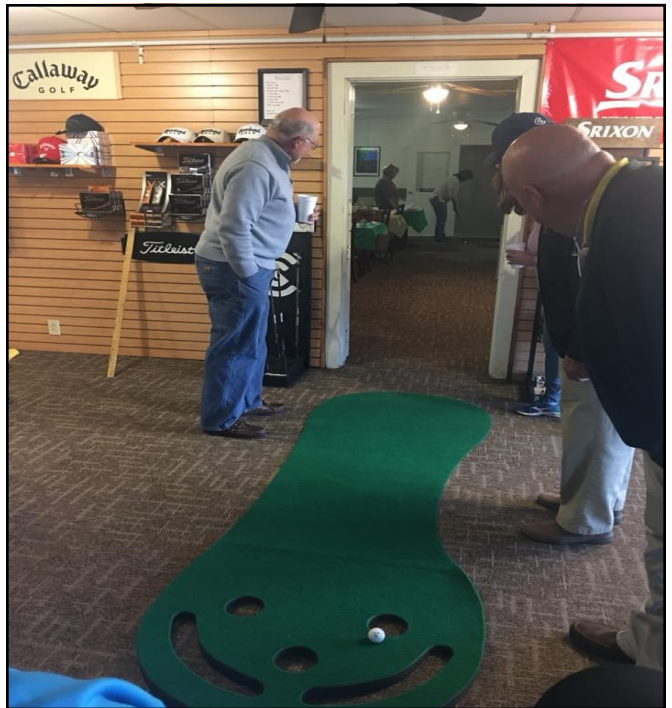
