

*Scoring for this has a little twist — see below.

You get to your target by scoring the following:

```
*Triple Bogey or worse = (-1) pts

*Double Bogey or worse = (0) pts

Bogey = 1 pt

Par = 2 pts

Birdie = 4 pts

Eagle or better = 8 pts
```

Gross

Straight up lowest score (no worse than triple bogey)

We will pay 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. You can only win in one category

Cost: \$5.00 plus applicable cart fees.

Golf News and Notes

New HDCP System

- Most of you have probably heard that the USGA has adopted a new handicap system called World Golf Handicap System. You can go to the USGA or the KYPGA website for more details.
- For those of you with the old GHIN app on your phone, you probably need to go in and update it. Once
 you've done that, you may need to know your GHIN number before being able to access. If so, Jimmy can
 provide you with that.
- Please note, most of you have your GHIN fee included in your dues and you will not see any disruption.
 For those that pay separately, please make sure to do so as soon as possible.
- If by March 15th, if we have not received your GHIN payment, we will have to deactivate you in the system
 so as not to be charged from the USGA. You can get reactivated simply by paying your GHIN fee to the
 club.
- Also please note that in all of the Men's Tournaments all players have to have an established USGA HDCP by June 1st to participate in the Calcutta's.

Pro Shop/Men's Locker Room Cleanup

- We are in the process of going thru these areas and throwing out items that we no longer use.
- If you feel like you might have something up there in danger of being tossed, we ask that you please come and get it.
- For some reason, there seems to be an over abundance of men's golf shoes laying around in the locker room. If you have shoes not in a locker, they need to find a home.....quickly.
- We're going to toss out all "homeless" shoes on March 1st, so you have a little time.

Pro-Shop Sign-In Sheet for Golf

- o We are asking for your cooperation this year as we re-implement the sign-in sheet for golfers. We ask that when you come in to pay that you tell the staff person your name and they will write it down on the sheet. Obviously, a lot of you are well known by most, but we have several new members and pro shop staff each year and this will help us with the following:
 - It will help all our staff get to know the members and their names regardless of whether they are new or let's say "seasoned".
 - It will ensure that we track rounds played and reconcile with our receipts to find any discrepancies and correct.
 - It will help us make sure we're capturing guest fees correctly as well as ensure that a Harrison County resident that is not a member is playing a maximum of 3 times.

MGA THURSDAY LEAGUE

Starts April 2nd thru September 24th

Teams:

- Made up of 4 players (You can play anytime Thursday that works for your team)
- \$20.00 entry fee per player and weekly fee of \$5 per player to the pot.
- Any new player added to a team during the playing season will pay the \$20 entry fee.

Format

- 9 Holes of stroke play, rotating tees each week.
- If you want to play 18 holes, great just play the "league" 9 first.

HDCP's:

- For returning players, you will begin with your Thursday League HDCP from last year.
- New players GHIN Handicaps will be used for the 1st week and League HDCP will then be established.
- 60 & over = Senior Tees
- 75 & over = Super Senior Tees

Subs

 If you would like to be an "on-call" Sub, please provide the Pro Shop your name and cell #. It is the responsibility of the team to contact the sub.

New for 2020

- Would like for each team to come up with a team name just to add a little "flavor" to the league. Be mindful not to add too much "flavor" or we'll have to re-name the team.
- There will be a "no higher than" HDCP limit of 18 for 9 holes.
- o If you have less than 4 players and can't find a sub for that day, you will be allowed to "draw" a player from those playing that day on another team. Each player participating on that Thursday will be assigned a number and you will draw as many as you need to fill out your 4-some and use their net scores to fill out your team total. *Note that you will be responsible to pay the \$5 weekly fee per player and while we would suggest that share any winnings with them, this is your call.

Scoring Details

- All four net scores will be used.
- o Gross score for each player will be entered on the scorecard as usual.
- On the bottom half of the scorecard the lowest net score of the team is entered in the Net1 line.
- Second lowest net score is entered in Net 2 line, etc, etc.
- Payouts will be:
- Net 1 lowest score 40% of pot.
- Net 2 lowest score 30% of pot.
- Net 3 lowest score 15% of pot.
- Net 4 lowest score 15% of pot.

- In order to play for a chance at all four prizes you must have four players.
- If you only have three players competing on any given day you will be playing for the first three places, etc, etc.

If there is a tie on any of the final net scores the monies will be split for that net score. There could possibly be ties on all 4 net scores.

All other net scores not in ties will pay as shown above.

We had 76 players participate in 2019. Please consider putting a team in for 2020! Want to play, but don't have enough for a team?

Let the Pro-Shop know - we'll try and hook you up with other teams looking for players.



I wanted to clarify something that we communicated earlier this week regarding the GHIN HDCP payments.

On April 1st, the Club will be billed \$23.00 for every golfer that we show as "Active" in our system. Obviously, we don't want to be billed for someone that hasn't paid their GHIN fee so we're trying to clean it up.

• How do I know if I've paid my GHIN fee?

- o Jimmy Fuller has a list in the Pro-Shop and he can tell you who we show as Active/Inactive. You can contact him at 859-234-5364.
- o If you pay your dues as a **Lump Sum**, it should be on your bill/invoice from the club. (If you've thrown your bill/invoice away and are unsure – contact David McIlvain)
- o If you pay by **Bank Draft**, you may or may not be including it in your monthly payment, so here again it's best to contact David McIlvain.
- o If you paid the club separately with a check either by mail or paid Jimmy at the club then you should be fine.

So what happens on March 1st?

On March 1st, golfers can start entering scores. If we don't have a record of you paying your GHIN, then we will have you listed as "Inactive" and you won't be able to do so until you pay the GHIN fee and become "Active."

If I'm "Inactive" and pay my \$25.00 GHIN fee after March 1st do I lose everything and have to re-establish my HDCP?

o No, this system allows us to "Activate" you with the click of a button and it's like it always was.
