

Format: 18 Holes –Daytona (No HDCPS)


- Each team of two add their scores together, so if they both had fours the score is 44. If the scores were different then the scoring depends on how you fared to par. If one of you got a **Gross Par** or better you would take the lower score first. For example, a 4 and 6 on a par 5 scores 46, a 5 and a 6 would score a 56. If you are both above **Gross Par**, say on a par three, then you would record a 44 regardless since the worst you can put down is a bogey. The lower total takes the money, but be prepared for some big swings.
- No HDCPS will be used and no worse than bogey can be recorded.
- Couple must be man/woman and can be husband/wife, boyfriend/girlfriend, father/daughter, mother/son, grandparent/grandchild, etc.

Scoring explained (Examples)


- *Par 3*
 - o Two Birdies 22
 - o One Birdie, One Par 23
 - o Both players par 33
 - o One Par, One Bogey 34
 - o Two Bogies 44 (highest score possible no worse than bogey)
- Par 4 o Two Birdies 33
 - o One Birdie, One Par 34
 - o Both players par 44
 - o One Par, One Bogey 45
 - o Two Bogies 55 (highest score possible no worse than bogey)
- Par 5 o Two Birdies 44
 - o One Birdie, One Par 45
 - o Both players par 55
 - o One Par, One Bogey 56
 - o Two Bogies 66 (highest score possible no worse than bogey)

Obviously there are several other scenarios, but the easiest way to remember is that the lowest score on a given hole is the first score of the two.
